#### Introduction

Bradford Culture Company (BCC) operating as Bradford 2025 (the Company) is seeking to appoint a suitably experienced and qualified contractor (the Provider) to build and paint the scenery, for a production of The Railway Children.

BCC would like to invite interested providers to tender for this business.

- The production takes place at Oxenhope Railway station

- The performance space is in traverse either side of a train track. The scenery includes a signal box, railway bridge, flooring to represent stone platforms and a large station window.

- Previous experience of set construction for theatrical performance
- Alignment with BCC's procurement objectives.
- Capacity to deliver within timescale.
- Local to Bradford/West Yorkshire.
- Value for money.
