Please note, Penistone Hill Country Park is not pushchair or wheelchair accessible.

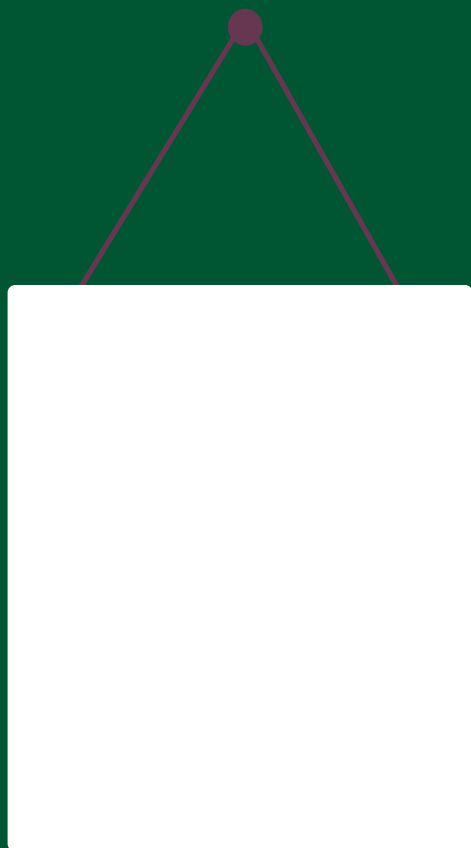

- IF YOU WERE A BUTTERFLY, WHERE WOULD YOU FLY TO?



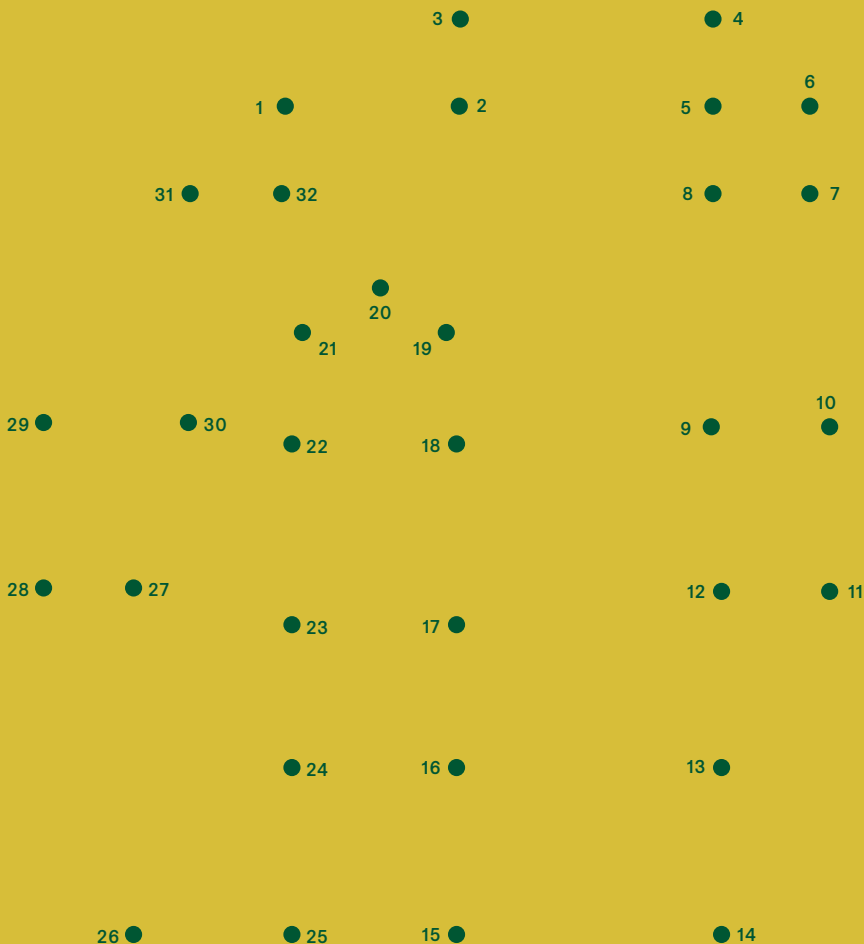
